During the winter months, we try and get outside as much as possible (even if it is only for a few minutes), therefore appropriate outdoor clothing is required. Please don't forget to label our child's clothing pieces.

As the weather gets nicer, we are given the opportunity to spend more time outside. We take an active role in applying sunscreen, water play, and keeping ourselves hydrated. Once again, please make sure that your child has appropriate clothing and towels, and please take them home weekly, in order to insure cleanliness.

Please remember, that we expect everyone to be able to go outside in a regular basis. However, if you feel that your child is unable to participate with their classmates, then you should keep them home that day.
